



Gracemere Market Report 01/09/2021

Vendors at CQLX penned 76 head more than last week for a total yarding of 3,054 head. Cattle were drawn from local areas along with a larger than normal number from Mackay and Nebo, north to Bowen and Mount Coolon. Quality was very mixed through most categories however, there were several quality lines in the heavy feeder steers and light weaner steer and heifer classes. Vealer steers averaged from 575c to 630c with vealer heifers averaging from 463c to 515c/kg, the best going to restockers. Light weight yearling steers under 280kg averaged from 573c to 622c, while medium and heavy pens averaged from 458c to 517c/kg. Light weight pens of yearling heifers returned improved averages from 466c to 482c/kg. The medium weight pens sold to a top of 527c to average from 437c to 521c/kg, reflecting the mixed quality on offer. Grown steers to 500kg going to feed averaged from 465c to 495c while heavy pens averaged 417c/kg. Bullocks to processors averaged from 360c to 407c/kg. Trade buyers purchased grown heifers to an occasional top of 443c to average from 360c to 374c/kg. Those to feed averaged between 411c and 436c/kg. Score 2 cows again sold well, reaching a top of 319c to processors with an average of 316c/kg. Heavy, 4 score cows averaged 333c, improving 5c/kg on last sale. Heavy bulls went to processors mostly and averaged 336c/kg. Cow and calf units sold from \$1,775 to \$2,425/unit.
