



# Gracemere Market Report 29/09/2021

CQLX Gracemere yarding decreased by 1,370 head to 3,288 after last week's increased numbers. Cattle came from the usual draw areas and although quality was good overall, it was a mixed yarding which showed the first drop in condition seen for some time. Competition for finished cattle came from the normal processors who were all keen to buy. Feeders were unchanged and restockers included a couple of new buyers along with the regular panel. Light weight yearling steers went to restockers mostly, to average from 576c to 587c and sell to 657c/kg. Medium pens averaged from 475c to 557c/kg, relative to breeding. The few heavy pens to feed averaged 491c/kg. Light weight yearling heifers sold to a top of 559c to average from 465c to 521c/kg to restockers. Those to processors averaged 460c to 496c/kg. Medium weight yearling heifers averaged from 420c to 465c with a few heavy yearling heifers to feed selling from 407c to 459c/kg. Feeders paid to a top of 483c for their best grown steers, averaging from 438c to 474c/kg. A few bullocks to processors made 407c to average 390c to 396c/kg. Feeders averaged from 409c to 428c for grown heifers, with those to the trade averaging 366c/kg. Score 2 cows went to processors to average 328c, while heavy 4 score cows averaging an improved 366c and topping at 381c/kg. Processors bought most heavy bulls to average 314c/kg. A small offering of cows and calves made from \$1,900 to \$2,125/unit whilst PTIC cows made from \$1,570 to \$1,850/head.
