A total of 4,845 head of cattle were consigned at Roma's Store Sale on Tuesday.

Weaner steers under 220kg topped at 830c/kg and averaged 684c/kg, weaner steers in the 220-280kg range reached 798c/kg and averaged 668c/kg. Steers in the 280-350kg range reached 722c/kg and averaged 603c/kg, and steers in the 350-400kg range reached 676c/kg and averaged 622c/kg. Feeder steers in the 400-550kg range topping at 602c/kg and averaging 548c/kg.

Cows and calves hit \$3,525 /unit.

BRF Southern, Breena Plains, St George sold Santa steers to 830c/kg, reaching a top of \$1,565 to average \$1,563.

Numbers rose to 4,845 at the Roma Sale despite recent rainfall across the region. Cattle were drawn from the usual supply area and the yarding included several quality local single vendor lines. Steers dominated the yarding which also saw increased numbers of cows and calves. A large buying panel was present and operating, including all regular processors, and with a strong lot feeder representation. The market strengthened further with steers, heifers and cows mostly improving, and a new top price record for Roma was set again. Light weight steers improved by 16c to 110c, while medium weight steers to feed improved by 32c, and heavy weight steers to feed improved by 26c/kg. Medium weight heifer to feed improved by 23c to 49c, while heavy weight heifers to feed improved by 27c/kg. Prime cows continue to sell to strong processor demand.

A small number of calves set a new record top price for Roma when they sold to 878.2c to average 853c/kg. Light weight yearling steers under 200kg reached 830.2c to average 709c/kg. Yearling steers under 280kg to restockers also reached 830.2c to average 725c/kg. Medium weight yearling steers under 330kg to restockers sold to 722.2c to average 694c/kg. Quality lines of local EU steers saw medium weight yearling steers under 400kg to feed sell to a top of 676.2c to average 634c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed were the largest sample for the day and reached a top of 602.2c to average 566c/kg. Light weight yearling heifers under 200kg to restockers reached a top of 705.2c to average 630c/kg. Yearling heifers under 280kg to restockers made to 754.2c to average 626c/kg. Medium weight yearling heifers under 330kg to restockers sold to 610.2c to average 592c/kg. Yearling heifers under 400kg to feed reached a top of 620.2c to average 573c/kg. Heavy weight yearling heifers to feed sold to 576.2c to average 492c/kg.

The best of the heavy weight grown steers made to 452.2c to average 449c/kg. The largest sample of grown heifers made to 432.2 to average 411c/kg. Heavy weight 3 score cows reached a top of 399.2c to average 392c, while heavy weight 4 score prime cows made to a top of 416.2c to average 412c/kg. The largest sample of heavy weight bulls reached a top of 390.2c to average 374c/kg. A large single vendor consignment of PTIC cows, along with cows and calves attracted strong restocker demand with PTIC red tag cows selling at open auction to a top of \$2775/head, while the cows and calves reached a top of \$3325/unit.
